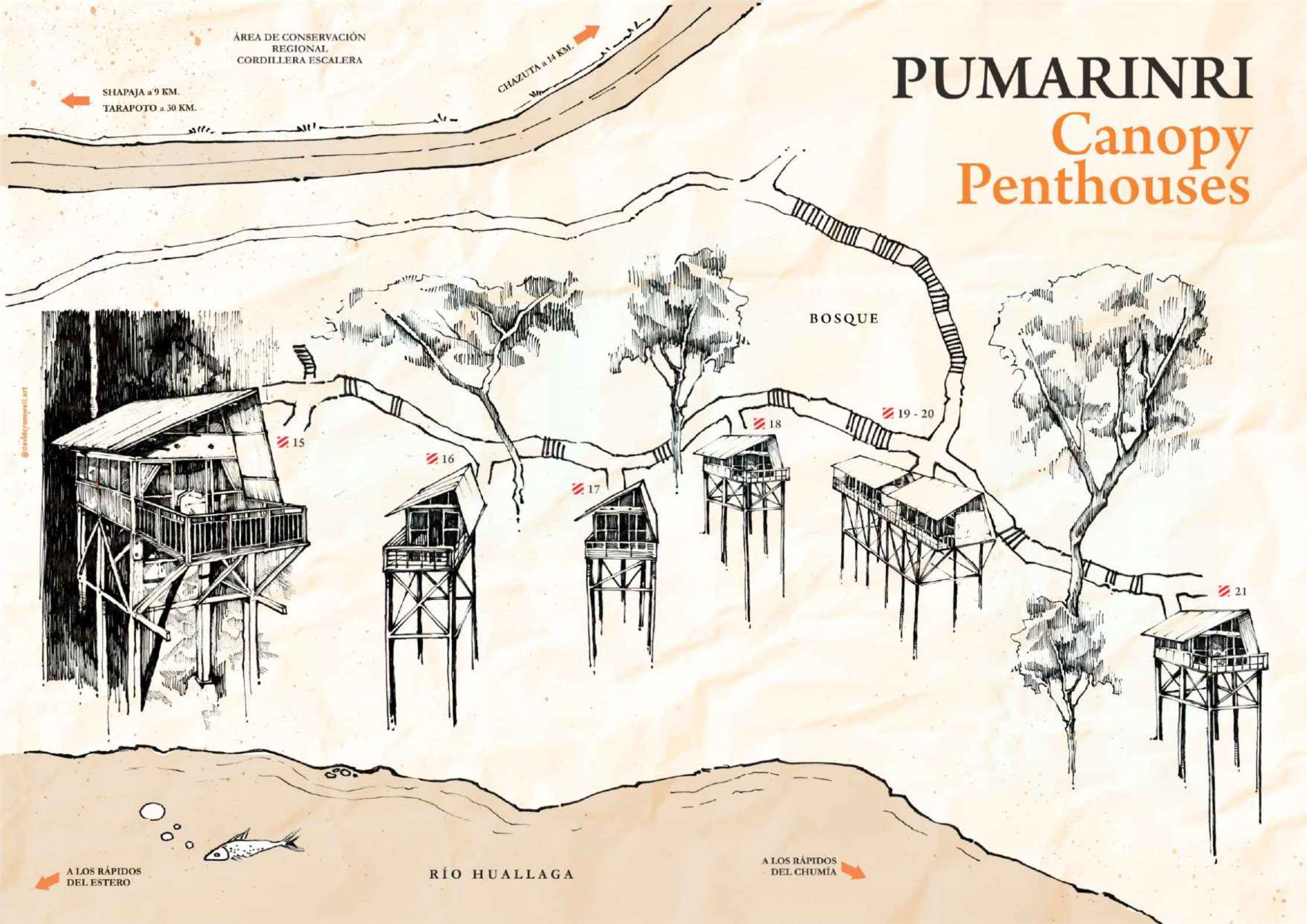

TYPES OF CANOPY PENTHOUSE

TYPE OF CANOPY PENTHOUSE

DOUBLE OR TRIPLE CANOPY: Ideal for friends, couples or families with a child over six years old.

They have two single beds that can be converted into a king bed, plus an extra single bed, in case a triple accommodation is desired.

TWIN CANOPY: A proposal of two cabins with the same design and capacity in each of them. Ideal for families and groups of friends, with the possibility of hosting children of any age.

Each room has a king size bed and a bunk bed with two single beds.



GENERAL INDICATIONS



LUGGAGE: We recommend to bring your luggage in a backpack or an easy to transport suitcase. The hotel does not provide luggage transfer service to the room.



CLOTHES/SHOES: We recommend to use convenient footwear for the path through the jungle trails, as well as swimsuit and rain protection.



LIGHTNING: The trail to the cabins does not have illumination, in order to avoid interrupting the forest night life. We recommend to prevent with flashlights.



REPELENT/SUNBLOCK: Its recommended the use of sunscreen with no less than 50fps and insect's repellent.



ROOM SERVICE: Not available in the canopy rooms

TOURS AND EXPERIENCES



JUNGLE AND PUCAYAQUILLO WATERFALL

A path totally surrounded by the flora and fauna of the forest will take us to see one of the most beautiful waterfalls of the region: Pucayaquillo.

RIVERS, JUNGLE AND BIRDS: FROM THE HUALLAGA TO THE MAYO

The meeting point between these two giants is located close to our lodge. Navigate both through their rapids and its calm waters while we do birdwatching with a long list of species to discover.

CHAZUTA: THE CHOCOLATE JUNGLE

There are thousand reasons to visit Chazuta. The river, the cacao, its pottery and all its cultural expressions are a world that every traveler should have in their list of things to discover.

PUMARINRI NIGHTWALK: THE JUNGLE TROUGH THE NIGHT

The jungle through the night is a whole different world. The life explosion that awakes when the sun goes down, shine with its own light. Owls, spiders, dardo frogs, and a sky that shows all the constellations from the south hemisphere.

ELECTRIC BIKE ROUTES

The road leading to Pumarinri follows the course of the Huallaga River, connecting the districts of Shapaja and Chazuta, making it ideal for cycling. Toward Chazuta, it is a 4 km stretch, an easy ride up to the Chumía rapids; in the opposite direction, the route is more challenging and full of interesting stops along the way.

PUYU VIEWPOINT

Located in the Cordillera Escalera, the Puyu Viewpoint offers sweeping views of the Huallaga Valley and the Vaquero forests, especially in the morning when the mist begins to lift. The viewpoint is an ideal spot to rest and take in the scenery before beginning the descent, which unfolds through open landscapes and a distinct forest dominated by quina quina trees.

INTI VIEWPOINT AND THE PUMARINRI TRAILS

From the Inti Viewpoint, we can enjoy the finest sunsets at Pumarinri every afternoon. However, the views over the Huallaga River hold a special charm at every hour of the day, especially early in the morning, when we can observe the lively activity of the paucar birds as they fly in and out of their hanging nests.

PUMARINRI PHOTOGRAPHIC ROUTE

The Pumarinri photographic route explores different areas of the lodge that stand out for their natural surroundings and the scenic views they offer. Along the way, six carefully selected stops invite guests to pause, observe, and capture each scene at a relaxed pace.
